## A NOTE FROM OUR PRESIDENT & CEO

Dear Friends,

With our Mission at the forefront of all that we do, D'Youville continues to grow and evolve our services to ensure that we are able to meet the changing needs of today's seniors and older adults. I am delighted to let you know that The Saab Residence recently received approval for the extension of its Assisted Living certification to include all 60 apartments, allowing residents to receive an even broader range of personalized services. Thanks to the generosity of our donors during our recent capital campaign, 30 apartments are reserved for seniors of low or moderate income who could not otherwise afford to live at an assisted living residence. We are so proud that our subsidy program also means that individuals paying market rate may continue to live in their same apartment should their funds be diminished.

Each month, approximately 100 persons are admitted to D'Youville's "Advanced Therapy" program for short term rehabilitation following surgery or illness, and most return home within just a couple of weeks. Whether such recuperation occurs at D'Youville Senior Care or at the D'Youville Center for Advanced Therapy (DCAT), our unified rehabilitation program ensures that the patient experience will be similarly superior at either site. In addition, we are currently in the process of renovating our short stay patient rooms at D'Youville Senior Care in order to mirror the spa-like environment of the DCAT. If you haven't been to D'Youville recently, I invite you to visit our website at [www.dyouville.org](http://www.dyouville.org).

We are all aware of the current scarcity of public funding, as well as rapid evolution in the health care delivery system. Reimbursement for skilled nursing care has not kept pace with increasing costs of providing care to individuals who are more medically complex than ever before. Despite D'Youville's status as the area's premier provider of elder care services, we are not immune from the financial challenges of today. Your continued contributions to D'Youville Life & Wellness Community help us to ensure that the legacy of our Sponsor, the Sisters of Charity of Ottawa, will thrive even in the face of uncertain times. On behalf of all those served on the D'Youville campus, a heartfelt thank you for your friendship and continued generous support.

# Adult Day Health Program Transitions to The Community Family

After 40 years of service to the Greater Lowell Community, D'Youville Life & Wellness Community closed our Adult Day Health program at the end of March. Fortunately, D'Youville and The Community Family, Inc. ("TCF") entered into a partnership that consolidated their Adult Day Health Care programs and extended other elder care services to a broader range of seniors in Greater Lowell.

As of April 1<sup>st</sup>, D'Youville ceased operations of Adult Day Health Care services. However, many of our clients have transitioned to Community Family's Adult Day Care programs at its 236 Broadway Street location in Lowell.

Naomi Prendergast, D'Youville's President and CEO and Anne Marchetta, Executive Director of Community Family announced the new partnership in mid-January.

Citing the implementation of new costly licensing regulations for Adult Day Health programs as increasing the expense of providing services and no increase in the state reimbursement rate for those services, the partnership with The Community Family was announced. This situation has presented challenges for all providers, especially those that run small programs like D'Youville's.

Through the collaboration with The Community Family, D'Youville's Adult Day Care clients took advantage of the larger program size and expertise in the field of Adult Day Health offered by The Community Family. TCF is a highly regarded provider of adult day services, with sites in Lowell, Everett and Medford, Massachusetts. In return, The Community Family's clients will have access to D'Youville's broader range of elder care services through a new preferred partner relationship between the two non-profit organizations. D'Youville offers long-term skilled nursing (nursing home) care including special care for persons with Alzheimer's and other forms of memory loss, short-term rehabilitation, short-term respite care, and affordable and market rate housing – independent living, assisted living and memory care assisted living.

Adult day health care ("ADH") is a structured program of health and supportive services designed to meet the individual needs of adults who need medical monitoring, supervision, personal assistance and socialization. Participants attend The Community Family's (TCF) centers on a planned basis for two to five days a week, where they will receive the care they need. Some attend ADH programs for years, while others may attend for short-term support while transitioning back to their homes from hospitals or rehabilitation.

Adult day health care also provides much-needed respite for caregivers who get relief from their care giving responsibilities knowing that their loved one is safe and well cared for. Services provided include nursing care, activities, nutrition, social work and assistance with activities of daily living.

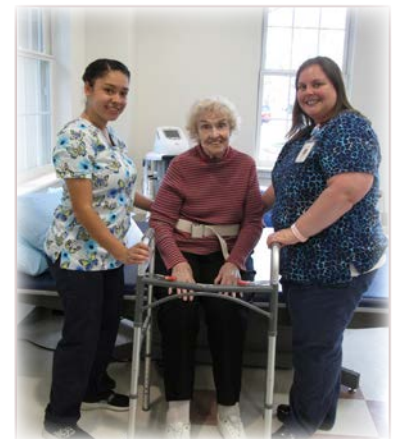

Advanced Therapy at D'Youville provides short-term rehabilitation for patients recovering from a variety of surgeries, injuries, or illnesses which would benefit from a stay in a skilled nursing environment. Some frequent conditions include:

- joint replacements or other orthopedic surgeries (including amputations)
- surgeries for medical conditions
- cardiac and pulmonary diagnoses (CHF, COPD)
- strokes and other circulatory issues
- chronic diseases such as Parkinson's disease

Our facilities include newly renovated semi-private and private rooms at D'Youville Senior Care and state-of-the-art accommodations at the D'Youville Center for Advanced Therapy. Both offer the same services, staff, activities, and dining options. Our patient centered approach ensures a comfortable stay for a rapid return to home.

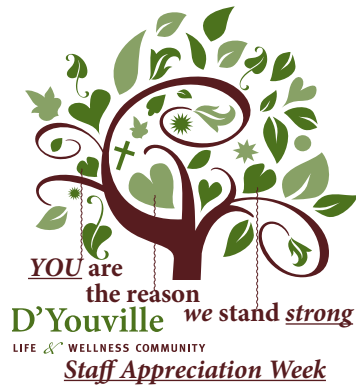

## PRESERVING THE LEGACY OF THE SISTERS OF CHARITY OF OTTAWA

The Sisters of Charity of Ottawa, “The Grey Nuns of the Cross,” arrived in Lowell in 1880 to provide education to the children of French Canadian immigrants. In the intervening years, they provided care for the poor, educated many thousands of young Lowellians and expanded their service to include care for the elderly. It was the Sisters’ vision and determination to build and manage a place where elderly people would be well cared-for in their remaining years that led to the establishment of D’Youville by its original name, D’Youville Manor.

Since opening in 1960, D’Youville has operated under the direction of the Sisters, initially very much with their direct, hands-on care, and by taking responsibility for virtually all other necessary tasks. Over the years, the Sisters’ numbers have diminished, and coinciding with that fact so has their capacity of work, as well as to oversee and provide guidance to D’Youville.

And so, earlier this year, the Sisters, in conjunction with the Board of Directors of D’Youville Life & Wellness Community, decided to pursue the transfer of Sponsorship - D’Youville’s connection with the Catholic Church - from the Sisters to the DL&WC Board. This decision on the Sisters’ part demonstrates their strong confidence in the capabilities of the members of the Board.

The transfer process will take a time to complete, but regardless of its outcome, we at D’Youville wish to recognize the vision, commitment and many achievements of the Sisters, and to preserve their Legacy. There are several ways in which we can do so, including:

- First, pursuing the transfer of Sponsorship from the Sisters to the DL&WC “Parent Board” is one way of honoring and preserving the Sisters’ Legacy.
- Second, through intelligent financial management overseen by the D’Youville Investment Committee, and growth of D’Youville’s endowment resulting from the fund raising work of the Foundation and its Board, we can plan wisely to conserve and develop resources that will provide for programs in the future that might not be affordable using public reimbursement funds.

- A third way in which the Sisters’ Legacy can be preserved is through the incorporation of elements of the s.c.o. identity into the daily flow of life and work at D’Youville.

One example of such integration of the Sisters’ identity is the recent renaming of the former first floor “Large Conference Room” to become the “s.c.o. Board Room.” This new title has given the prominent and often used meeting space a more definitive identity that helps to perpetuate the Sisters’ legacy.



A second example was initiated when the D’Youville “Parent Board” voted at its July, 2017 meeting to approve the modification of the D’Youville logo to incorporate colors and graphic elements from the s.c.o. logo (left) into the existing D’Youville logo. The redesigned D’Youville logo (below) maintains its popular “tree” while adding:

- the rich s.c.o. blue as the color of the “D’Youville”;
- the ivy vine from the s.c.o. logo now also wraps around the D’Youville tree;
- the red heart from the Sisters’ logo is reflected in the red “heart-shaped” leaf in D’Youville’s;
- and, the gold s.c.o. cross is mirrored in the now-gold cross in the D’Youville tree.

We hope that you will like these respectfully colorful changes in the D’Youville logo, and appreciate their intended purpose of recognizing and preserving the Legacy of the Sisters of Charity of Ottawa, who have done so much for Greater Lowell and D’Youville.
