Notes from Naomi: Transfer of Sponsorship

As you have heard, The Sisters of Charity of Ottawa initiated a search for a new Catholic sponsor for D'Youville due to their declining numbers. Together with our Board of Directors, the Sisters examined a number of options before concluding that D'Youville Life & Wellness Community's identity as a Catholic health organization will be preserved through a transfer of sponsorship to another highly-qualified Catholic order, the Carmelite Sisters for the Aged and Infirm. In addition, D'Youville will join the Carmelite System, a Catholic not-for-profit health system based in Germantown, NY. Currently, the sponsorship transition process is well underway. We are awaiting essential approvals from the Vatican, the Commonwealth and HUD but are confident that these entities will agree that the Carmelite Sisters are the perfect successor to the Sisters of Charity of Ottawa. We are hopeful that all approvals will be received, and sponsorship transition completed by the end of this year or very early 2020. We look forward to introducing you to the Carmelite Sisters and would like to assure our residents, families, supporters and employees, that D'Youville will remain D'Youville.
